




2023 TORONTO CHINATOWN FESTIVAL VISITOR SURVEY




2023 TORONTO CHINATOWN FESTIVAL VISITOR SURVEY

Income





Rental Fee:

Non-Profit Organization \$350 + tax = \$395.5

General Merchandise & Services \$800 + tax = \$904

Food & Beverages \$1,600 + tax = \$1,808
